It was a hopeless and desperate life. But that's behind him now. Clean and sober, Joel came to MEND after completing rehab, hoping to stay busy while looking for a job. He was struggling financially and in his personal life, but he also knew that nothing good would come out of idleness.

He showed up day after day, helping where he could. Then one day he learned that a job had opened up as a Warehouse Driver. It seemed so perfect! He approached a caseworker for help with putting a resume together, coaching and support. He was nervous, but he applied for the job. On the third day he was called in for an interview and shortly after he received the great news that he had been hired! Today Joel is a new man. Sober, employed and on his way to achieving his dreams, thanks to people like you.

Mark is rebuilding his life thanks to your generosity

Mark was at MEND at his grandmother's recommendation: "MEND will give you a chance, despite your past," she said.

So, here he was, nervously waiting to speak to someone.

He needed help with finding a place to live. Recently out of



jail, Mark shared that he was making do, sleeping on the floor, in his grandmother's tiny home. After the initial euphoria following his release, he was beginning to worry about what to do next. Mark was finding that a criminal record made it challenging to reintegrate into society and rebuild his life.

"Because I took a wrong turn doesn't mean I can't change direction," he said.

He talked, and we listened, about the extreme mental stress he was experiencing and the fear he had of never catching up with his contemporaries. That was a lot! Our case worker helped him co-create a plan to meet his goals. First, he applied for and received his basic ID documents, then MEND worked with another organization to find him a place to live. He was ecstatic! Now Mark is enrolled in MEND's Gateways employment services and is busy looking for work. He recently stopped by with smiles and thanks that touched our hearts. But the thanks is really for you... for your care for people like Mark. With you and MEND in his corner, he is rebuilding his life.

MEND's **Community Nourishment Programs** feed hundreds of thousands of people in need of food through a Food Pantry (direct distribution), Food Bank (distribution to partners), Buen Provecho farmers market & Health "Store". Demand remains high, but your help enables us to put canned & dry goods, meat, eggs, dairy and fresh fruits & vegetables in the hands of hungry people in Los Angeles.

Consolidated under one umbrella called **Here We Thrive**, our **case management services** offer interventions to help participants address the root causes of their struggles, access housing, mental health & other resources through partners, regain their health, and find & keep a job.

MEND's **Hope & Care** outreach services continued in 2022, providing help with COVID vaccines and wellness support.

First Step services are open every Thursday with direct and indirect services for people who are homeless.

MEND remains a place where people in crisis can find help with rental & utilities assistance, diapers, and other essential services.

And, finally, year after year, MEND sets aside time to restock backpacks for low-income children and celebrate the holidays with those who are homeless and marginalized.
